

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

The present communication is being filed in response to the office action dated March 27, 2004, a reply to which is due September 27, 2004. Withdrawal of the rejection and reconsideration are respectfully requested. Please amend the above-identified application as follows:

IN THE DESCRIPTION OF GOODS:

Please delete the present description and substitute therefor:

International Class 30: Packaged and prepared staple foods, namely pasta, rice, and cheese, entrees consisting primarily of pasta, rice, cheese, pasta and cheese, or rice and cheese, meals consisting primarily of pasta, rice, cheese, pasta and cheese, or rice and cheese, pasta sauce, cheese sauce, snack foods, namely crackers, popped corn, pretzels, baked dried pasta snacks, cheese-flavored snacks, namely cheese balls, cheese curls.

Remarks

In the outstanding office action, the Trademark Examining Attorney indicated that the identification of goods was unacceptable because it was indefinite. Applicant has, in accordance with the Examining Attorney's suggestion, amended the list of goods to be definite. Entry of this amendment and reconsideration are respectfully requested.

In the outstanding office action, the trademark examining attorney has indicated that a search of the office records has uncovered no similar registered or pending mark which would bar registration under Trademark Act §2(d), 15 U.S.C. §1052(d). Applicant acknowledges this statement, and with the present amendment, requests allowance to publication.

Based on the amendment and remarks above, withdrawal of the rejection and reconsideration are respectfully requested.




