Second Request For Extension Of Time To File Notice Of Opposition

Sir:

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 2.102(c)(3), the potential opposer, CollaGenex Pharmaceuticals, Inc ("CollaGenex"), having its place of business at 41 University Drive, Suite 200, Newtown, Pennsylvania 18940, by and through its attorneys hereby requests that the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board of the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("the Board") grant an additional sixty (60) day extension of time to file a Notice of Opposition in the above-identified matter. Counsel for the Applicant has consented to the requested extension.

On November 16, 2004, CollaGenex filed its first request for an extension to file a Notice of Opposition. Pursuant to CollaGenex' request, the Board granted a ninety (90) day extension for filing the Notice of Opposition, making February 16, 2005 the new deadline for filing the Opposition or a further request. The additional sixty (60) day extension requested would make April 17, 2005 the new deadline for CollaGenex' to file its Opposition.

A further extension of sixty (60) days is necessary to investigate and evaluate the necessity of filing a Notice of Opposition. Counsel for CollaGenex has been communicating with counsel for Applicant, Connetics Corporation ("Connetics"), in an attempt to resolve this






