The Examining Attorney has requested remand of the application in order to enter an amendment to the identification of goods. The Examining Attorney has indicated that applicant has consented to the remand, and that the amendment will avoid the refusal of registration.

In these circumstances, the request for remand is granted. Action on the appeal is suspended and the electronic record of the application file is herewith remanded to the Examining Attorney.
