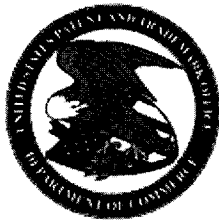

Dear Commissioner for Trademarks:

Credit Union National Forms Association, Inc. ("CUNFA") filed requests for extensions of time to file notices of opposition against the eight trademark applications referenced above and owned by Credit Union National Association ("CUNA"). CUNFA also previously petitioned to cancel CUNA's trademark registration, CUNA, U.S. Reg. No. 1,243,837. (*See* Opposition No. 91201120.)

The parties subsequently settled the trademark opposition and all disputes between them. CUNFA has also expressly abandoned its trademark Application Serial No. 85/153,461, which was the basis for the cancellation proceeding and possible opposition proceedings. Attached please find our documentation of abandonment. Because CUNFA has no intention of filing notices of opposition against any of the above-referenced marks, it therefore requests that the Board withdraw all of the requests and allow the applications to proceed.
