On July 7, 2014, applicant filed a request to suspend and remand the application to the Trademark Examining Attorney. The applicant seeks to have the Examining Attorney review its renewed claim of acquired distinctiveness of the subject mark. In support of its claim, applicant has submitted the “Declaration of its CEO” and “Declaration of two of its customer...”.

In view of the reasons given therein, the request for remand is granted for good cause shown. Action on the appeal is suspended, and the file is remanded to the Examining Attorney.

In the event registrability is found, the appeal will be moot and the Board should be so informed. In the event the refusal of registration is maintained, the file should be returned to the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board, proceedings will be resumed and applicant will be allowed time in which to file its brief on appeal.
