This order supersedes the Board's order (dated December 5, 2016) in order to comply with the Board's new procedures for scheduling oral hearings.

This appeal is fully briefed, and Applicant's request for an oral hearing (filed December 2, 2016) is noted. The request does not suggest possible dates and times for the hearing. As for the method of participation, Applicant has not indicated plans to participate by video conference.

Because the request does not suggest possible dates and times for the hearing, Applicant is allowed until 15 days from the mailing date of this order in which to submit, through ESTTA, a supplemental notice (1) providing three tentative dates and times for the hearing, such dates being between **May 15, 2017 and August 1, 2017**, and (2) informing the Board if Applicant plans to attend by video conference. In settling on possible dates, Applicant must note that hearings are held on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Eastern Time. Also,

it will be beneficial for Applicant to consult with the Examining Attorney when considering dates to suggest for the hearing. If Applicant fails to file a response to this order, the request for an oral hearing will be considered waived, and the matter will be submitted for decision on the record and briefs. TBMP § 1216.]

If Applicant plans to attend the hearing by video conference, a USPTO video conference technician will contact Applicant to arrange a test of the equipment provided by the party to facilitate attendance by video conference. It is the responsibility of any party planning to participate by video conference to make appropriate arrangements with the video conference technician to allow such participation. The USPTO is not responsible for providing parties with the means to participate by video conference.

Once the Board has confirmed the hearing date and time, the Board will issue written notice thereof. *See* Trademark Rule 2.129(a) and TBMP § 1216.
