REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE APPLICANT'S BRIEF

Applicant, Kurt Geiger Limited, hereby requests a ninety (90) day extension of time to file its brief in support of *ex parte* appeal in the matter of Application under Serial No. 86/696,276, until April 21, 2017. The appeal was received by the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board on October 27, 2016. The brief is currently due on January 21, 2017.¹

An extension of time for filing an appeal brief in an *ex parte* appeal to the Board may be granted upon written request showing good cause for the requested extension. See TRADEMARK TRIAL AND APPEAL BOARD MANUAL OF PROCEDURE § 1203.02(d). Applicant submits that good cause exists for the requested extension. This is the first request for an extension of time by Applicant. Applicant is attempting to negotiate a consent agreement with the owner of the trademark registrations cited by the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office as obstacles to registration of Applicant's trademark. Applicant and the owner of the cited registrations have exchanged communications through counsel. Applicant is hopeful that, if given additional time for negotiations to continue, Applicant and the owner of the cited registrations will reach a consent agreement that would obviate the need for the Board to expend further resources on this appeal.

¹ The Trademark Trial and Appeal Board's Order dated November 21, 2016 sets the date on which the Applicant's brief is due on January 21, 2017. However, because that date falls on a Saturday, Applicant's brief would be timely if filed on Monday, January 23, 2017. See 37 C.F.R. § 2.196; see also TRADEMARK TRIAL AND APPEAL BOARD MANUAL OF PROCEDURE § 112.

For the foregoing reasons, and for good cause shown, Applicant respectfully requests that the Board grant a ninety (90) day extension of time to file Applicant's brief.
