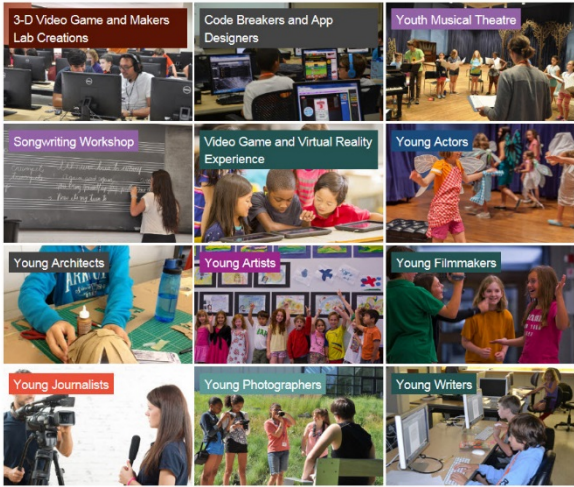

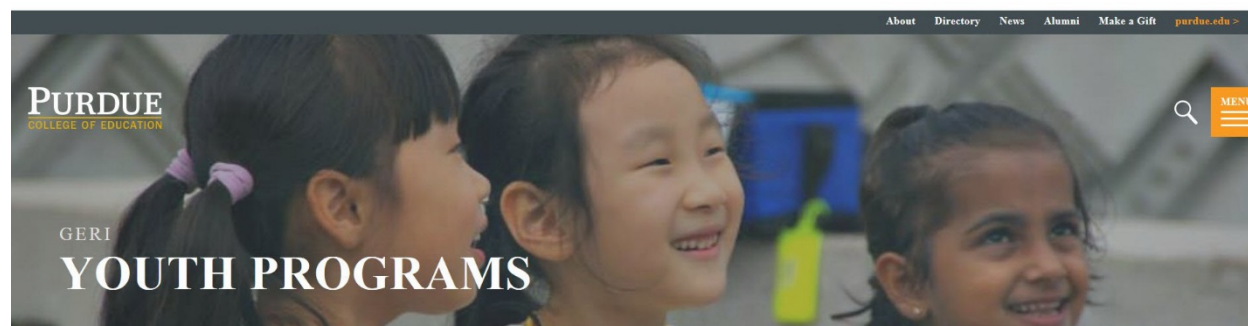
Trio Program
