MOTION TO REQUEST SUSPENSION OF THE APPEAL AND REMAND OF THE APPLICATION FOR FURTHER EXAMINATION

Before the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board on Appeal

An oral argument is scheduled in this matter on Wednesday, March 27th, at 11:00 am. However, the trademark examining attorney requests that the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board suspend the appeal proceedings and remand the application to the trademark examining attorney pursuant to TBMP §1213. It has come to the examining attorney's attention that one of the cited registrations, U.S. Registration

No. 4275485, entered the grace period for renewing its registration after briefing was completed in this matter. This is one of two cited registrations that is the subject of the instant appeal.

On remand, the trademark examining attorney intends to suspend the application pending final disposition of one of the cited registrations. If the cited registration is cancelled for failure to renew, then the oral argument may be rescheduled as to the remaining cited registration.
