Applicant hereby requests the Commissioner, pursuant to TBMP § 1203.02(d), to extend the time for filing an appeal brief in this action for one (1) month, up to and including August 10, 2023.

The case is now scheduled for a final briefing and decision. Applicant's counsel has been preparing for and is beginning an emergency injunction hearing on a trademark infringement case in the Southern District of Florida, that began today (July 10, 2023) in the case of *La Potencia, et al v.
