OPPOSER'S MOTION
TO EXTEND TIME TO RESPOND TO DFI'S DISCOVERY

Opposer, Reed Elsevier Properties, Inc., hereby requests that the Honorable Board grant Opposer a one-month extension of time to respond to "DFI's First Set of Interrogatories and Requests to Produce."¹

DFI's discovery requests were served on Opposer on November 20, 2001. Responses are currently due on December 25, 2001. If this motion is granted, Opposer's time to respond to DFI's discovery requests will expire on January 25, 2002.

As good cause for this motion, Opposer cites the intervening Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays, which have disrupted the usual business schedules of Opposer and its client, as well as the extended sickness of Opposer's counsel for several weeks after the Thanksgiving holidays. This is the only extension Opposer has sought of Opposer's time to respond to discovery in this case. Opposer responded to Applicant's First Set of Interrogatories and Requests to Produce within thirty-five days from their service.

WHEREFORE, Opposer respectfully requests that its time to respond Applicant's discovery requests be extended to January 25, 2002.


