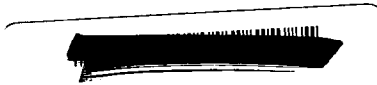

TO FURTHER SUSPEND THE PROCEEDINGS**






