Again I thank you for taking the time to assist me during that extended telephone conversation last week. I have rewritten the G&S description to emphasis the exclusivity of the newsletter as you suggested and have attached it to this message. I would look forward to any further suggestions you may have on this issue.

I have argued this distinction in my Response to Examining Attorney's Determinations, under EARLIER FILED PENDING APPLICATIONS, Paragraph (3), which was originally mailed on July 30, 2001, and sent again by facsimile on August 19, 2001, when there was some delay in the earlier copy reaching your desk.

Is it possible that I could request that my application be removed from suspension based on arguments presented above as well as this possible change in the Goods and Services description? Omnimedia, the holder of the two referenced marks, Serial numbers 75767741 and 75767742, has gone into Chap. 7, and its remaining assets, including the two marks just reference will be auctioned later this month in Pittsburgh at the US Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania. This Association does not have the assets to enter a bid. The marks already have a standing Opposition which may not be resolved for years. Could you inform me as to the steps necessary to initiate a "removal from suspension" and, equally important, what are the chances of such an action?
