PC Club, Opposer, hereby requests that the discovery and testimony periods in this matter be extended for 120 (days) days as follows:


Discovery Period to Close:	February 1, 2006

contact her client. Due to the circumstances, Applicant's counsel is unable to stipulate to extend discovery although, Applicant's counsel confirmed in writing on July 29, 2005 that they would not object to this request for extension. 


