Because the parties are negotiating for possible settlement of this case, proceedings herein are suspended until six months from the mailing date of this action, subject to the right of either party to request resumption at any time. See Trademark Rule 2.117(c).

Additionally, the Board notes that the parties have sought numerous extensions of time since opposer commenced this opposition in 2001. Thus, in the event the parties seek any further extensions of time or suspension of proceedings, the parties must provide a detailed report on the progress of their settlement negotiations to establish good cause for any continued suspension. Their report must include a recitation of issues that have been resolved, a recitation of issues that remain to be resolved, and firm timetable for resolution.

**Absent such a report, any future motion to extend or suspend may not be approved, even though agreed to by the parties.**

In the event that there is no word from either party concerning the progress of their negotiations within the next six months, the Board will issue an order resuming proceedings and resetting trial dates, including the time for discovery.

If, during the suspension period, either of the parties or their attorneys should have a change of address, the Board should be so informed.
