On February 5, 2003, applicant's time to answer was reset. Applicant was allowed until March 17, 2003 to file its answer.

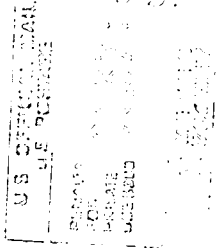
