On June 2, 2003, applicant filed a proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 76/256,207, with opposer's consent.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of goods **from** "Power operated machines, namely concrete saws and saw blades" **to** "Power operated machines, namely concrete saws and saw blades, but not including reciprocating saws and saw blades."

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

Applicant's motion (filed June 2, 2003) to suspend these proceedings for six months, or until December 2, 2003, with consent is granted and proceedings herein are suspended until December 2, 2003 and resume on December 3, 2003.

If the amendment resolves the dispute herein, opposer is allowed until **thirty days** from the resumption date of these proceedings, i.e., January 2, 2004 to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. See Trademark Rule 2.106(c).
