Sir:

In the matter of the above-identified proceeding, Johns Manville International, Inc. ("Applicant"), and Roos International, Ltd. ("Opposer"), through their attorneys, request that the time for filing an Answer to the Notice of Opposition be extended for an additional period of thirty (30) days, to and including March 31, 2003.

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The Notice of Opposition in this proceeding references exhibits 1-24. The exhibits were not included in the copy of the Notice of Opposition provided to Applicant by the Board. On February 6, 2003, counsel for Applicant wrote a letter to Opposer's counsel requesting a copy of the exhibits. On that same date, Applicant received a response from Opposer's counsel via facsimile stating that Opposer could not provide a copy of the exhibits to Applicant due to the bound nature and volume of the exhibits, and the fact that Opposer had filed an additional copy of the exhibits with the Board for service on Applicant. On February 10, 2003, Applicant's counsel sent a letter to the Board in which it requested that the Board provide a copy of the exhibits to counsel. As of this date, Applicant has not received from the Board the exhibits to the Notice of Opposition.

Based on the foregoing, good cause for the extension exists. Applicant should be allowed to see the exhibits referenced in the Notice of Opposition prior to responding to the allegations set forth in the Notice of Opposition.


This extension is requested to allow Applicant time to receive and review the exhibits to the Notice of Opposition and not interposed for the purpose of delay.

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
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
