In the matter of the above-identified proceeding, Johns Manville International, Inc. ("Applicant"), and Roos International, Ltd. ("Opposer"), through their attorneys, request that the time for filing an Answer to the Notice of Opposition be extended for an additional period of seven (7) days, to and including April 7, 2003.

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The Notice of Opposition in this proceeding references exhibits 1-24. The exhibits were not included in the copy of the Notice of Opposition provided to Applicant by the Board. Applicant has sought to obtain the exhibits from Opposer's counsel and from the Board, but to date has not received the exhibits. Although Applicant believes that it should be allowed to see the exhibits referenced in the Notice of Opposition prior to responding to the allegations set forth in the notice, Applicant does not wish to have this proceeding delayed further. Accordingly, Applicant intends to file an answer on or before April 7, 2003, whether or not it has been served with a complete copy of the Notice of Opposition with exhibits.

This extension is requested to allow Applicant time to prepare its answer and not interposed for the purpose of delay.




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
