On April 11, 2005, the parties filed applicant's proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 76389585, with opposer's consent, and opposer's withdrawal with prejudice of the opposition, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment, applicant seeks to delete the word **"PROSCUITTO"** from the recited goods so that the amended identification of goods reads as follows:

"Meat products, namely, mortadella, dry sausage, capocollo, and salami" in Class 29.

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed with prejudice.
