OPPOSER'S MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEEDINGS

Pursuant to 37 CFR § 2.117(c) and TBMP Section 510.03(a), Opposer, Sidney Frank Importing Co., Inc., moves this Board to suspending proceedings for three (3) months.

In a letter dated June 10, 2004 (Exhibit A) Applicant, through its attorneys, presented a settlement offer. Opposer's attorney responded in a letter dated July 13, 2004 (Exhibit B) informing Applicant that Opposer was negotiating with a third party regarding the sale of the GREY GOOSE trademarks which form the basis of the opposition proceedings. Further, Opposer suggested that the proceeding be suspended pending assignment of the trademarks. Thereafter, Opposer's successor-in-interest would be in a position to consider Applicant's settlement offer. Opposer requested that Applicant consent to such suspension; however, no response was received.

By letter dated July 20, 2004 (Exhibit C) attorney for Opposer repeated the request that Applicant consent to a suspension. In a letter dated July 23, 2004 (Exhibit D) Applicant refused to consent to a suspension; however, repeated its offer of settlement.

Although Applicant has refused to consent to the requested extension, Applicant continues to proffer its offer of settlement. Opposer's testimony period is scheduled to open on July 26, 2004; therefore, Opposer requests that the Board suspend these proceedings for three (3) months. During such time Opposer expects to complete the assignment of the GREY GOOSE trademarks. Thereafter, Opposer's successor-in-interest will consider Applicant's pending settlement offer, possibly rendering these proceedings moot.

In the alternative, Opposer requests that Opposer's testimony period, and all other trial dates, be reset.


