 27 **application, serial no. 76/383,884, for the mark REDEX;**

1 WHEREAS, on June 27, 2003, Re/Max International, Inc. ("Re/Max") filed an Opposition to
2 CSW's service mark application;

3 WHEREAS, CSW and Re/Max have, in good faith, continued negotiating possible settlement
4 terms;

5 WHEREAS, the conclusion of the discovery period is October 11, 2004; and


6 WHEREAS, on September 20, 2004, Re/Max's counsel agreed to extend the discovery cut off
7 and testimony periods,

8 NOW THEREFORE, the parties, by and through their respective counsel of record, hereby
9 stipulate and agree, subject to approval of the Board, to continue the discovery cut off and testimony
10 periods as follows:

- 11 1. Conclusion of discovery shall be continued from October 11, 2004 to December 10, 2004.
- 12 2. Conclusion of 30-day testimony period for plaintiff shall be continued from January 9,
13 2005 to March 9, 2005;
- 14 3. Conclusion of 30-day testimony period for defendant shall be continued from
15 March 10, 2005 to May 10, 2005; and
- 16 4. Conclusion of 15-day rebuttal testimony period for plaintiff shall be continued from
17 April 24, 2005 to June 24, 2005.


