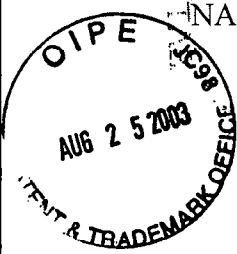

STIPULATED MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEEDINGS FOR THREE MONTHS




