**STIPULATED MOTION TO AMEND APPLICATION
AND DISMISS OPPOSITION PROCEEDING**

Applicant, Women of Wrestling, Inc., and Opposer, EMI Christian Music Group, Inc., pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 2.133 and TBMP §§ 501 & 514, submit this stipulated motion requesting the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board to (1) approve an amendment to the subject Application Serial No. 76/144,172, adding the phrase “featuring professional wrestling matches” at the end of the recitation of services, and (2) subject to the Board’s approval of such amendment, dismiss with prejudice this Opposition No. 91159718.

Applicant and Opposer have entered into an Agreement fully executed as of September 20, 2004, in which each party has agreed to certain covenants and restrictions with respect to the use of their respective marks for the purpose of avoiding a likelihood of confusion. As part of that Agreement, the parties have agreed to a dismissal of this Opposition on the condition of the Board’s approval of an amendment to the recitation of services in the subject Application as set forth herein.

The Proposed Amendment

The proposed amendment to Application Serial No. 76/144,172 serves to clarify or limit, and does not broaden, the scope of the final clause of the recitation of services (“television program syndication”) by adding at the end thereof the phrase, “featuring professional wrestling matches.” This limitation is consistent with the other entertainment services referenced in the recitation, all of which expressly pertain to professional wrestling. As amended, the recitation of services in the Application (all in International Class 41) would read in its entirety as follows:

Entertainment in the nature of professional wrestling matches and exhibitions and ongoing television programs in the field of professional wrestling; organizing and conducting professional wrestling matches and exhibitions; production of television programs and video recordings featuring professional wrestling matches, exhibitions and performances; television program syndication featuring professional wrestling matches.

The proposed amendment does not require republication of the Application and otherwise complies with the requirements of 37 C.F.R. §§ 2.71 to 2.75 (including, in particular, 37 C.F.R. § 2.71(a)).

On the basis of the foregoing, and with Opposer’s consent and agreement, Applicant requests the Board’s approval of the amendment to the Application’s recitation of services as set out above.

Dismissal of Opposition


