On June 29, 2004, applicant submitted an unsigned document entitled "Stipulation of Withdrawal of Opposition Proceeding" and a consented motion to extend applicant's time for file an answer to the notice of opposition. Applicant's motion to extend is granted to the extent that applicant has until THIRTY DAYS from the mailing date to file an answer or other response to the notice of opposition. Alternatively, the parties have the same THIRTY DAYS to submit an executed stipulation to withdraw the opposition.

If the parties do not submit an executed stipulation to withdraw the opposition, the following discovery and trial schedule will be in effect:

DISCOVERY PERIOD TO CLOSE:

June 1, 2005

Thirty-day testimony period for party in position of plaintiff to close:

August 30, 2005

Thirty-day testimony period for party in position of defendant to close:

October 29, 2005

Fifteen-day rebuttal testimony period to close:

December 13, 2005

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rule 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.
