On November 12, 2004, the parties filed applicant's proposed amendment to its application Serial Nos. 78102114 and 78183734, with opposer's consent, and opposer's withdrawal without prejudice of the opposition, which was filed November 23, 2004, and the Board dismissed the opposition on November 30, 2004. The amendment was filed after the Board's decision dismissing the opposition.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of goods in International Class 9 in both applications **from** "integrated, in-vehicle communications system consisting of radio, satellite and telephone transmitters and receivers; computer hardware, namely, microprocessors; and short and long range wireless devices, namely cellular telephones and apparatus and components thereof for data communication, satellite communication and telecommunication which interface with global positioning

system satellite technology for navigation systems" to "integrated, in-vehicle communications system consisting of radio, satellite and telephone transmitters and receivers; computer hardware, namely, microprocessors for data communication, satellite communication and telecommunication which interface with global positioning system satellite technology for navigation systems."

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).
