Upon review it appears that applicant's proposed amendment to its mark from RUBBERKOTE to HENRY RUBBERKOTE, approved by the Board in its April 11, 2007 order, was not accompanied by a substitute drawing.<sup>1</sup>

Applicant is allowed until twenty days from the mailing date of this order to submit a substitute drawing which shows the amended mark.

Opposer's consented motion to extend discovery and trial dates is granted. Dates are reset as set forth in opposer's March 5, 2008 consented motion.
