

Q Good morning.

A Good morning.

Q Can you please state your name?

A Tom Hoyes.

6 title was senior director, post-merger was elevated  
7 to a vice-president position.

8 Q And what are your responsibilities in that  
9 position?

10 A I'm responsible for all public sector  
11 sales within the north region. What I mean by that  
12 is north region is Virginia north, visualize the  
13 northeast corridor, and public sector is all  
14 federal, state, local, education, health care,  
15 utility sales and of course within that is public  
16 safety customers.

17 Q So Sprint/Nextel does market its services  
18 to the public safety sector?

19 A Absolutely.

20 MR. WILLIAMS: Objection, leading.

21 Q Do your responsibilities include marking  
22 Sprint/Nextel services to the public safety sector?

1           A     Absolutely.

2           Q     What types of groups, I know we already  
3     discussed some of this, but what types of groups  
4     does the public safety sector comprise?

5           A     Police, fire, we kind of -- internally we  
6     refer to it as guns and hoses, police, fire, health  
7     care, utilities, post 911 other groups have been  
8     brought in the umbrella of public safety but  
9     basically guns and hoses.

10          Q     At what governmental level does  
11     Sprint/Nextel market these services?

12          A     All levels, federal, state, local,  
13     municipal, all branches of public sector.

14          Q     Does Sprint/Nextel currently have  
15     customers in the public safety sector?

16          A     Absolutely.

17          Q     Can you identify some examples of  
18     Sprint/Nextel customers in public safety sector?

19          A     Sure.  NYPD, New York Police Department,  
20     D.C. Metropolitan Police Department, D.C. fire, New  
21     York fire, Boston Police, FBI, Secret Service, so  
22     on, so on, a lot of customers.

1 Q Does Sprint/Nextel consider Motorola to be  
2 a competitor in the public safety sector?

3 A Absolutely.

4 Q How so?

5 A We're both trying to sell devices to the  
6 same customer base.

7 MR. SAUERS: That's all the questions I have.

8 MR. WILLIAMS: Let me take a short break, look  
9 through my notes. Before we do that, however, I do  
10 want to raise a couple of objections that I raised  
11 yesterday with Mr. Rasmussen.

12 First, I want to object that Mr. Hoyes was  
13 not disclosed in Nextel's discovery responses as  
14 having any knowledge on any issues in this case  
15 including the topics in which you provided some  
16 testimony here today. And, secondly, I want to also  
17 object that Motorola was unable to conduct any  
18 discovery of Mr. Hoyes because he wasn't disclosed,  
19 therefore, we've been prejudiced in our preparation  
20 today for this testimony and we ask that the board  
21 strike this witness's testimony. And if we can take  
22 a short break, I'll see what I'm going to do on

1 cross.
