IN SUPPORT OF WRITTEN
OBJECTIONS TO EVIDENTIARY
STATEMENTS**

Despite the efforts of Opposer Royal Labs to shift the focus away from the merits of Applicant Visual Changes' evidentiary objections, Visual Changes' evidentiary objections should be sustained because they are properly directed at Opposition Paragraph Nos. 3 & 4 (and the attached flyer).

Opposer's Response to Applicant's Motion to Strike attempts to argue that Opposition Paragraph No. 3 should not be stricken while admitting its evidentiary nature. This is evidenced by Opposer citing Harsco Corp. v. Electrical Sciences Inc., 9 U.S.P.Q.2d 1570 (T.T.A.B. 1988) for the proposition that, "[i]f evidentiary facts are pleaded, and they aid in giving a full understanding of the complaint as a whole they need not be stricken."
