MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Applicant, Visual Changes Skin Care International, Inc. ("Applicant"), hereby request an extension of time through January 31, 2006, to respond to Opposer's requests for production of documents, interrogatories, and requests for admission, served Saturday, December 10, 2005, immediately before the close of discovery on Monday, December 12, 2005. Applicant's responses would otherwise be due Tuesday, January 17, 2006.

Applicant and Opposer have continued to discuss settlement, and negotiations recently resumed after a hiatus. If the matter can be settled, which (without describing the discussions) seems at least reasonably possible, Applicant would save the significant time, effort, and expense required to respond to the discovery.

Nothing is on the calendar that would make the requested extension cause any difficulty. There is nothing scheduled in the near future. No other deadline is required to be changed.

The undersigned requested agreement from Opposer, and Opposer indicated that there was no disagreement to an extension of this length, but Opposer wished to condition its agreement on certain conditions that seemed impractical to Applicant. Time considerations prevented further negotiations to remove those conditions. Accordingly, Applicant simply requests the Board to extend the time. Opposer has not identified any reason why an extension would prejudice it, and none is apparent.
