On December 18, 2007, the Board suspended proceedings pending disposition of Opposition No. 91161887 as a decision in Opposition No. 91161887 may render this proceeding moot.

On August 22, 2008, the Board sustained the opposition against applicant in Opposition No. 91161887 on final decision, refusing registration to applicant of the mark in application Serial No. 75900317. Accordingly, that application, which is also involved in this opposition, now stands abandoned. See Trademark Rule 2.136 and TBMP Section 807 (2d ed. rev. 2004).

While the entry of judgment in the other opposition and resulting abandonment of the application does not dictate that judgment automatically be entered in this case, the application shall remain abandoned. Opposer is allowed until **THIRTY DAYS** from the mailing date of this order to inform the Board whether it wishes to go forward and obtain judgment on the opposition. If opposer fails to respond

to this order, the opposition will be dismissed as moot.

It is noted that on October 16, 2008 and October 29, 2008, the Board mailed orders to applicant with respect to the granting of applicant's withdrawal of counsel; however both orders have been returned to the Board as undeliverable. It is applicant's responsibility to maintain an updated correspondence address with the Board and failure to do so may result in judgment being entered against applicant for loss of interest in this case.

Proceedings herein remain otherwise suspended.
