NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

In the matter of trademark Application Serial No. 76/183,043 for the mark EVIVI:
filed December 18, 2000 and published for opposition in the *Official Gazette* of July 27, 2004.

Biogen MA Inc., a Massachusetts corporation having an address of 14 Cambridge
Center, Cambridge, MA. 02142, formerly Biogen, Inc. ("Biogen"), believes that it will be
damaged by the registration of the mark shown in the above-identified application for the goods
identified therein and hereby opposes the same. The grounds for opposition are as follows:

1. Galileo Laboratories, Inc., a California corporation ("Applicant") seeks to register EVIVE as a trademark for dietary and nutritional supplements inter alia, as evidenced by the publication of the mark in the *Official Gazette* of July 27, 2004.

2. The application herein opposed was filed December 18, 2000 on the basis of "intent to use".

3. Biogen is and has been engaged in research and consultation services in the field of biotechnology and in connection with pharmaceutical preparations for more than twenty (20) years, and has built a successful business in connection therewith.

4. Biogen has used AMEVIVE as a mark in commerce in connection with pharmaceutical preparations for use in the treatment of dermatological disorders; pharmaceutical preparations for use in the treatment of autoimmune disorders; pharmaceutical preparations for use in the treatment of inflammatory disorders; pharmaceutical preparations for use in the treatment of psoriasis since August 9, 2000. Material showing Biogen's use of the AMEVIVE mark is available at the Biogen website www.amevive.com and attached as Exhibit A.

5. Biogen has secured and is the owner of U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,470,063 directed to the AMEVIVE mark. This registration is valid and subsisting. The pertinent information about this registration from the USPTO website is attached as Exhibit B

6. Biogen's application, Serial No. 75/514,383, which matured to registration as Registration No. 2,470,063, was filed on the basis of intent to use on July 6, 1998, so that July 6, 1998 is Biogen's priority date for its AMEVIVE registration.

7. Since Biogen is the owner of U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,470,063, priority is not in issue.

8. Biogen's AMEVIVE mark is inherently distinctive as applied to Biogen's pharmaceutical preparations.

9. By virtue of Biogen's continuous use in commerce of its AMEVIVE mark as shown in Exhibit A in connection with such pharmaceutical preparations, such pharmaceutical preparations have become well and favorably known to the relevant trade and public under such mark.

10. In the application herein opposed, there are no restrictions on trade channels, so it must be assumed that the goods identified in the application will travel through all trade channels appropriate for goods of that type.

11. Applicant's mark is confusingly similar to Biogen's AMEVIVE mark in sound and appearance and commercial impression. Applicant's mark appropriates five of the seven letters of Opposer's mark and is identical to the terminal portion of Opposer's mark. The two marks are such as are pronounced in a similar manner, i.e. "am-a-veev" and "a-veev".

12. Biogen's and Applicant's goods are closely related, namely Biogen's pharmaceutical preparations for the treatment of inflammatory disorders and Applicant's supplements. While the precise nature of the supplements is not set forth in the application opposed, no indications are excluded. Supplements generally include preparations directed to Applicant's cardiovascular health and inflammatory disorders. Applicant's website http://www.galileolabs.com/news_pr_061599.html indicates that it in fact offers supplements for conditions which are related to those identified in Biogen's registration for its AMEVIVE preparation.

13. The pharmaceutical preparations identified in the application herein opposed are such as are customarily sold and marketed through overlapping channels of trade as

Biogen employs. Therefore, Applicant's goods are such as will travel through the same and overlapping channels of trade as Biogen's.

14. Applicant's EVIVE trademark as applied to the goods set forth in the application herein opposed so resembles Biogen's AMEVIVE mark for Biogen's pharmaceutical preparations that it is likely to cause confusion, mistake, and/or deception.

15. If Applicant is permitted to register EVIVE for the goods set forth in the application herein opposed, confusion of the relevant trade and public is likely to result, which is likely to damage and injure Biogen and patients who may be subject to medication error.

16. Physicians, pharmacists and others in the relevant public are likely to misapprehend Applicant's mark as AMEVIVE and/or believe in error that goods offered under the EVIVE mark are offered by or in association with or under license from Biogen.

17. Any defect, objection to or fault found with Applicant's goods sold under the mark EVIVE would necessarily reflect on and seriously injure the reputation that Biogen has established for its pharmaceutical preparations.

18. Biogen previously objected to registration of the mark of the application herein opposed, and Applicant represented in writing that it would withdraw the application. Applicant has subsequently proceeded in breach of its commitment as set out in the communications attached as Exhibit C.

19. If Applicant is granted a registration for the mark herein opposed, it would obtain thereby at least a prima facie exclusive right to use the mark. Such registration would be a source of damage and injury to Biogen.


WHEREFORE, Biogen prays that registration of the mark of Application Serial No. 76/183,043 for the goods identified therein be refused and that this Opposition be sustained.

EXHIBIT A

Biogen's Use of AMEVIVE Mark



AMEVIVE® (alefacept)

AMEVIVE is indicated for the treatment of moderate-to-severe chronic plaque psoriasis in adults who are candidates for systemic therapy or phototherapy. The treatment is administered via IM injection once per week for 12 doses.

Important Safety Information

AMEVIVE® reduces the number of T cells, which are one of the body's ways to fight off cancer and infections. This could increase the possibility of getting cancer and serious infections. Before taking AMEVIVE, be sure to tell your doctor if you have had cancer or a serious infection.

Among 1,357 patients treated in clinical studies, 25 patients were diagnosed with 35 cancers. 23 were skin cancers and 3 were cancers of the lymph system. There were 19 patients (1.5%) who experienced serious infections. The most frequent infections were wound infections (4) and pneumonia (3).

During and after taking AMEVIVE, if you notice anything unusual about your health or any signs of infection such as swollen glands, fever or chills, notify your doctor right away.

Fatal Infusion Reactions:

Dear Ms. Jacobs-Meadway:

After further discussion and consideration of your draft settlement agreement, Galileo Laboratories Inc. ("Galileo") has decided that it cannot accept the limitations that you are seeking in that agreement, in part, because it simply cannot agree to the definition of auto-immune. Moreover, Galileo is not willing to sign any agreement that does not include restrictions on your client's part, including an agreement not to oppose or otherwise object to the E-VIVE mark and a further agreement to refrain from use of AMEVIVE on or in connection with nonprescription pharmaceuticals or nutritional supplements. Rather than continue to spend time and fees in further negotiation of this agreement, I have been authorized to inform you that Galileo will refrain from using the EVIVE mark on or in connection with any goods, and will withdraw its EVIVE applications and registrations around the world. Galileo reserves the right, however, to proceed with its use of the E-VIVE mark and prosecution of applications for the E-VIVE around the world. Galileo also will not agree to limit the goods and/or services with which the E-VIVE mark can be used. As set forth in detail in my earlier correspondence, it is our view the EVIVE mark was quite distinct from your client's AMEVIVE mark. The addition of the hyphen in E-VIVE provides more than adequate


