On August 18, 2006, applicant filed a proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 75938020, with opposer's consent.¹

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of goods **from** "prerecorded compact discs in the field of computer-related information and computer information technology" **to** "prerecorded compact discs in the field of computer-related information and computer information technology, excluding blank magnetic and optical storage devices and supplies and equipment for computers and printers." International Classes 16 and 42 remain unchanged.

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer

consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If this resolves the dispute herein, opposer is allowed until thirty days from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. See Trademark Rule 2.106(c).
