MOTION TO EXTEND GRANTED

Euronda S.p.A.'s consent motion filed, Jun 20, 2005, to extend the discovery period until Nov 16, 2005, is granted.

DISCOVERY PERIOD TO CLOSE: Nov 16, 2005

Thirty-day testimony period for party in position of plaintiff to close: Feb 14, 2006

Thirty-day testimony period for party in position of defendant to close: Apr 15, 2006

Fifteen-day rebuttal testimony period

to close:

May 30, 2006

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony, together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rule 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.
