On December 23, 2005, the parties filed a stipulated amendment to application Serial No. 78349624, and opposer's withdrawal without prejudice of the opposition, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of goods **from** "metal bakeware" **to** "metal bakeware not sold in grocery, drug or convenience stores."

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed without prejudice.¹

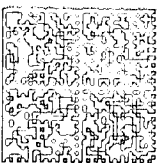
