



NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

This Notice of Opposition relates to the application of WRG Services, Inc. ("WRG Services") of Willoughby, Ohio, in International Class 9, shown in Application Serial No. 78/316,739, filed on October 21, 2003, and published in the Official Gazette on April 19, 2005.

Analog Devices, Inc. ("Analog Devices"), organized and existing under the laws of the state of Massachusetts, having a place of business at One Technology Way, Norwood, Massachusetts 02062, believes that it will be damaged by registration of the mark  and hereby opposes the same.

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The grounds for opposition are as follows:

1. Analog Devices is a corporation duly organized under the laws of the state of Massachusetts, having a place of business at One Technology Way, Norwood, Massachusetts 02062. Analog Devices has made extensive and exclusive use of the trademark





in various forms at common law since at least as early as March 1965 in connection with packaged electronic modules, namely, operational amplifiers and power supplies; since as least as early as February 1969 in connection with analog- to-digital and digital-to-analog converters; since as least as early as 1971 in connection with instrumentation and isolation amplifiers, analog computational circuits, converters, voltage references, transducers, sample/track-hold amplifiers, data-acquisition modules, switches, multiplexers, monolithic chips, linear IC testers, analog multipliers/dividers, log-antilog amplifiers, signal conditioners, digital panel meters, microcomputer I/O subsystems comprising input/output boards, computer programs for electronic data processors for computer based measurement of signals, computer programs for electronic data processors for computer based measurement and display of input signals and computer programs for electronic data processors for computer based measurement of input signals and generation of output signals in response to measured input signals for control thereof, digital thermometers, and computer interface products, namely, real-time interface card; and since at least as early as August 1991 in connection with integrated circuits. Analog Devices is also the owner of the following trademark registrations:

2. Notwithstanding Analog Devices' use of the  trademark in connection with packaged electronic modules, namely, operational amplifiers and power supplies; analog- to-digital and digital-to-analog converters; instrumentation and isolation amplifiers, analog computational circuits, converters, voltage references, transducers, sample/track-hold amplifiers, data-acquisition modules, switches, multiplexers, monolithic chips, linear IC testers, analog multipliers/dividers, log-antilog amplifiers, signal conditioners, digital panel meters, microcomputer I/O subsystems comprising input/output boards, computer programs for electronic data processors for computer based measurement of signals, computer programs for electronic data processors for computer based measurement and display of input signals and computer programs for electronic data processors for computer based measurement of input signals and generation of output signals in response to measured input signals for control thereof, digital thermometers, and computer interface products, namely, real-time interface card; and integrated circuits, WRG Services filed an application under Serial No. 78/316,739 on October 21, 2003 to register the mark  for automatic teller machines, self-service transaction devices, components, computer software and kits therefore, namely, computers, computer network circuits and cards, peripherals, and computers, computer network circuits and cards for remote monitoring of automatic teller machines and self-service transaction devices; operating software for financial service applications and software for automatic teller machines and self-service transaction devices; and security hardware consisting of tamper resistant

computer network circuits and cards for automatic teller machines and self-service transaction devices.

3. The WRG Services'  trademark is confusingly similar to Analog Devices'  trademark which is protected by the above registrations and at common law.

4. Potential purchasers of WRG Services' products are likely to believe that such products originate with, or are authorized or approved by Analog Devices when, in fact, they are not.

5. Confusion between the marks  and  is likely, since Analog Devices' goods and WRG Services' goods would travel in the same channels of trade.

6. If WRG Services is granted the registration on the application herein opposed, it would thereby obtain a prima facie exclusive right to use the mark  which would be a source of damage to the Analog Devices' trademark rights.

WHEREFORE, Analog Devices believes it will be damaged by said application for registration and prays that this Opposition be sustained under 15 U.S.C. §1052(d).
