Applicant's proposed amendment filed November 28, 2005 is noted. On October 5, 2005, applicant filed a proposed amendment to amend its application Serial No. 78316739, with opposer's consent. On October 19, 2005 the Board denied applicant's proposed amendment because it exceeded the scope of the identification of the goods. In response applicant has now filed a new amendment which it feels is acceptable.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of goods **from:**

International Class 09: Automatic teller machines, self-service transaction devices, components, computer software and kits therefore, namely, computers, computer network circuits and cards, peripherals, and computers, computer network circuits and cards for remote monitoring of automatic teller machines and self-service transaction devices; operating software for financial service applications and software for automatic teller machines and self-service transaction devices; and security hardware consisting of tamper resistant computer network circuits and cards for automatic teller machines and self-service transaction devices

to:

International Class 09: Automatic teller machines, self-service transaction devices, automatic teller machines and self-service transaction device components, computer software and kits, namely, computers, computer network circuits and cards, and peripherals, all of the aforesaid for use with automatic teller machines and self-service transaction devices; computers, computer network circuits and cards for remote monitoring of automatic teller machines and self-service transaction devices; operating software for financial service applications and software for automatic teller machines and self-service transaction devices; and security hardware consisting of tamper resistant computer network circuits and cards for automatic teller machines and self-service transaction devices

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If this resolves the dispute herein, opposer is allowed until **thirty days** from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. See Trademark Rule 2.106(c).
