The Board's May 10, 2006 order in this consolidated proceeding stated that discovery closed December 16, 2005. This was true for the parent case, Opposition No. 91164326. In Opposition No. 91166064, the Board's institution and trial order set discovery to close February 16, 2006, and thus discovery was still running when opposer filed its December 23, 2005 motion for summary judgment.

On February 24, 2006, the Board consolidated these proceedings. Upon consolidation, the Board usually will reset trial dates for the consolidated proceeding by adopting the trial dates as set in the most recently instituted of the cases being consolidated. TBMP §511 (2nd ed. rev. 2004).

Accordingly, discovery and trial dates in the consolidated proceeding are reset to reflect the dates in Opposition No. 91166064:

DISCOVERY PERIOD TO CLOSE:	July 14, 2006
Thirty-day testimony period for party in position of plaintiff to close:	October 12, 2006
Thirty-day testimony period for party in position of defendant to close:	December 11, 2006
Fifteen-day rebuttal testimony period to close:	January 25, 2007
