On March 30, 2006, applicant filed a proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 78382602, with opposer's consent.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of goods in International Class 16 by adding the language "all relating to a Minor League Baseball team" at the end of the description of goods so that the description read as follows:

"Paper Goods and Printed Matter, namely autograph books, binders, bookmarks, bumper stickers, calendars, catalogs of interest to baseball fans, decals, merchandise bags, newsletters of interest to baseball fans, note pads, paper containers, paper pennants, paper schedules, pens, pencils, postcards, posters, printed awards, printed game tickets, printed guides of interest to baseball fans, reference books of interest to baseball fans, score books, score cards, score sheets, stationery,

stickers, sticker albums and trading cards all relating to a Minor League Baseball team."

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If this resolves the dispute herein, opposer is allowed until **thirty days** from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. See Trademark Rule 2.106(c).
