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**REQUEST TO AMEND IDENTIFICATION OF GOODS IN TRADEMARK
APPLICATION**

This matter having been settled, contingent upon the amendment of the above-referenced application, and pursuant to the terms of the parties' settlement agreement, Applicant Kabushiki Kaisha Hitachi Seisakusho d/b/a Hitachi, Ltd. ("Hitachi") submits this request to amend said application.

1. Hitachi requests that the identification of goods in this application be amended as follows:

Strike the existing identification of goods in Classes 10 and 16 and insert the following in their place:

International Class 10: Artificial limbs and teeth; orthopedic articles, namely, dermatologic orthopedic instruments, namely, scalpels, forceps, and artificial limbs; suture materials, namely, sutures, thread, and needles, for medical use; medical equipment, namely, tomographs, tomography units, x-ray units, x-ray generators, ultrasonic blood flow monitors, ultrasound cardiogram units; radio therapeutic microtron systems; scintillation cameras for medical use used to detect gamma rays emitted from radioactive medical agents and to image the distribution of radioactive medical agents injected into a patient; bio-clean units for hospital operating rooms comprised of sanitized and sterile air conditioning, sanitary and electrical apparatus to block entry of bacteria, to prevent collection of bacteria, to prevent generation of bacteria, and to eliminate bacteria; CT scanners; magnetic resonance imaging equipment; ultrasound scanners

International Class 16: Printed matter, namely, newsletters, manuals, pamphlets, brochures, annual reports, and journals in the fields of semiconductor manufacturing, computer software and hardware, power systems, metals, chemicals, power tools, engineering, telecommunications, audio-visual communications, multimedia presentations, charitable foundations, digital media,

home electronics, consumer appliances, engineering, and information technology; bookbinding materials, namely, bindings, bookbinding tape, bookbinding glue, bookbinding wire, and cloth for bookbinding; stationery; adhesives for stationery or household purposes; artists' materials, namely, paints, pencils, markers, and stencils; paint brushes; typewriters; office supplies, namely, punches, rubber bands, staplers, paper embossers, and paper cutters; printed instructional and teaching materials in the fields of semiconductor manufacturing, computer software and hardware, power systems, metals, chemicals, power tools, telecommunications, medical devices, audio-visual communications, multimedia presentations, charitable foundations, digital media, home electronics, consumer appliances, engineering, and information technology; plastic materials for packaging, namely, plastic envelopes and plastic bubble packs for wrapping or packaging; playing cards; printers' type; printing blocks; catalogs in the fields of semiconductor manufacturing, computer software and hardware, power systems, metals, chemicals, power tools, telecommunications, medical devices, audio-visual communications, multimedia presentations, charitable foundations, digital media, home electronics, consumer appliances, engineering, and information technology; PVC stretch film for food; pencil sharpeners; electric letter openers; electric pencil sharpeners

2. Applicant submits this amendment to the identification of goods is proper, inasmuch as it represents a narrowing of Applicant's original identification of goods, which was previously approved for registration.

3. This amendment has no affect on the other goods and services in other classes identified in the above-referenced application and all such goods and services shall remain in the application as published for opposition.

4. This amendment is being submitted with the consent of Inspire Pharmaceuticals, Inc.
