
On December 21, 2005, we submitted a timely Notice of Opposition to registration of design mark Ser. No. 76/604,040, the fee of \$300, and the receipt postcard on behalf of Societe Nationale des Chemins de Fer Francais-S.N.C.F., Societe Nationale des Chemins de Fer Belges-S.N.C.B., and Eurostar (U.K.) Limited et al. (collectively "Opposer"). Copies of the Notice of Opposition, the check stub, and the receipt postcard are enclosed with this letter.

On February 27, 2006 we sent a letter, a copy of which is enclosed with this letter, inquiring as to the status of the Notice of Opposition because the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("PTO") website did not contain a record of the Notice of Opposition. The PTO website still shows no record of the Notice of Opposition, but rather indicates that as of April 4, 2006 a Notice of Allowance has issued for the application. We are enclosing a print-out of the TARR page of the PTO website for the challenged application. We sent a follow up letter on April 4, 2006, a copy of which is enclosed, but have received no response from the PTO and it still appears that the opposition has not been initiated.

NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

Opposers, Société Nationale des Chemins de Fer Français – S.N.C.F., an industrial and commercial public establishment organized and existing under the laws of France, having an address at 88 rue Saint-Lazare 75009 Paris, France; Société Nationale des Chemins de Fer Belges – S.N.C.B., a public limited company organized and existing under the laws of Belgium, having an address at 85 rue de France 1070 Bruxelles, Belgium; and Eurostar (U.K.) Limited, a private limited company organized and existing under the laws of the United Kingdom, having an address at 3-5 Rathbone Place London W1P 1DA, Great Britain (hereinafter referred to collectively as “Opposers”), by and through their attorneys Hughes Hubbard & Reed LLP,

believe that they will be damaged by the registration of the Miscellaneous Design Mark in the name of BaggageDirect.com, Inc. ("Applicant"), published in the Official Gazette on August 30, 2005, depicted in Schedule A hereto (the "Applied-for Mark"), and hereby oppose the same.

This Opposition is timely because on September 29, 2005 the United States Patent and Trademark Office Trademark Trial and Appeal Board granted Opposers request for an extension of time to oppose until December 28, 2005.

As grounds for this Opposition, Opposers rely upon the rights developed by them and related companies and allege on knowledge as to themselves and otherwise upon information and belief, as follows:

1. On September 11, 2001, prior to Applicant's filing of its application, Opposers obtained United States Registration No. 2,486,433 for the Miscellaneous Design Mark ("Opposers' Mark") for a variety of goods and services, including, but not limited to, "baggage check services for travelers; packing and wrapping baggage for protection during travel; . . . cargo handling and unloading; parcel delivery" and other travel-related goods and services. (See Exhibit B hereto.)

2. Opposers' registration is valid and subsisting, unrevoked and uncanceled, and is prima facie evidence of the validity of Opposers' exclusive right to use Opposers' Mark in commerce in connection with the goods and services specified in Opposers' registration without condition or limitation, and constitutes constructive notice of Opposers' ownership of Opposers' Mark for the goods and services described in the registration, as provided for by §§ 7(b) and 22 of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C.A. §§ 1057(b) and 1072 (2005).

3. On July 20, 2004, Applicant filed an intent-to-use service mark application for the Applied-for Mark. The application covers the following services: "Baggage pick-up and delivery services" in International Class ("IC") 39.

Count: Likelihood of Confusion

4. Opposers hereby incorporates by reference the allegations in Paragraphs 1 through 3 hereof as if fully set forth herein.

5. The Applied-for Mark, as set forth in the application opposed herein, is substantially similar in commercial impression to Opposers' Mark. Both marks contain three parallel wavy lines, which are nearly identical in appearance to each other. The image of the suitcase in the Applied-for Mark is generic or descriptive as the covered services related to the pick-up and delivery of suitcases. Accordingly, the suitcase element is weak and entitled to a narrow scope of service mark protection, if it is entitled to any protection at all. The portion of the marks in common, namely, the three parallel wavy lines, is the portion with trademark significance.

6. The Applied-for Mark and Opposers' Mark cover the same services, namely services relating to the movement of baggage in IC 39.

7. Accordingly, the Applied-for Mark is likely to cause confusion, mistake, or to deceive the public into believing that Applicant's goods and services are somehow affiliated or associated with, connected to or sponsored by Opposers, in violation of Section 2(d) of the Lanham Act.

8. If Applicant is permitted to register or use the mark herein opposed, confusion would be likely as to the sponsorship of the services, resulting in damage and injury to Opposers by reason of the similarity between the Applied-for Mark and Opposers' Mark. Persons familiar with Opposers' Mark will be likely to purchase Applicant's services, believing them to be affiliated or associated with, connected to or sponsored by Opposers. Likewise, persons exposed to the Applied-for Mark who subsequently become acquainted with Opposers' Marks are likely to conclude that the goods and services offered by Opposers under their mark are in some

manner affiliated or associated with, connected to or sponsored by Applicant. Any such confusion as to sponsorship inevitably would result in damage and injury to Opposers.

9. Opposers will be damaged by registration of the mark shown in the application opposed herein because such registration will support and assist Applicant in the confusing and misleading use of the Applied-for Mark, and will give color of rights to Applicant in violation of Opposers' prior and superior statutory and common-law rights in the Opposers' Mark.

WHEREFORE, Opposers request that this Opposition be sustained and that the application for registration of the Applied-for Mark be denied in all respects.
