Opposer's consented motion filed September 17, 2010 to extend the time to produce responsive documents and to extend discovery and trial dates is noted.

Inasmuch as opposer has provided the Board with a report on the progress of the parties settlement discussions as required in the Board July 27, 2010 order, the motion is granted. Trademark Rule 2.127(a).

The time to produce responsive documents and to extend discovery and trial dates are reset in accordance with the schedule set forth in opposer's consented motion.

In order to avoid undue delay to the progress of this proceeding, the parties are advised that if another

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extension or suspension is required after this period expires, the parties will be expected to report on the progress of their settlement discussions to establish good cause for any further motion to extend or suspend. This report should include: a recitation of issues that have been resolved, issues that remain to be resolved, and a firm timetable for resolution. Absent such a report, any future motion to extend or suspend may not be approved, even though agreed to by the parties.

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rule 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.¹
