**MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE CANCELLATION PROCEEDING WITH
OPPOSITION PROCEEDINGS PURSUANT TO FRCP RULE 42(a)**

Respondent/Applicant, Game Show Network, LLC, a limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, located at 2150 Colorado Avenue, Santa Monica, California, 90404 hereby moves to consolidate the above cancellation proceeding with the opposition proceedings, which were previously consolidated.

On May 31, 2006, Harrah's filed Notices of Opposition against Game Show Network's applications for the mark WORLD SERIES OF BLACK JACK in Classes 41 (Opp. No. 91171182), 28 (Opp. No. 91171183), and 25 (Opp. No. 91171184). Game Show Network moved to consolidate the three oppositions on July 17, 2006. The Board granted the motion on July 20, 2006.

On September 6, 2006, Harrah's petitioned to cancel Game Show Network's Reg. No. 2999068 for the identical mark, WORLD SERIES OF BLACKJACK for "entertainment services; namely, providing a television game show program." Game Show Network filed its response on October 16, 2006.

The principal issue in the oppositions and the cancellation action is whether there is a likelihood of confusion between Harrah's use and registration of WORLD SERIES OF POKER and Game Show Network's use and registration of WORLD SERIES OF BLACKJACK. As such, the proceedings share common issues of both law and fact.

Federal Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 42(a) permit a court to consolidate proceedings in actions involving a common question of law or fact. FRCP Rule 42(a). All of the proceedings contain a number of common questions of law and fact.

Consolidation of the actions will save the parties and the Board time, effort and expense; which are the factors considered by the Board in determining whether to consolidate actions.




