**Andrew P. Baxley, Interlocutory Attorney:**

On June 12, 2007, opposer filed a motion to extend testimony periods herein. In view of the time-sensitive nature of that motion, the Board determined that this motion should be resolved by telephone conference. When the Board attorney assigned to this case contacted applicant's attorney to schedule such conference, applicant's attorney stated that he has stipulated to the extension sought.

In view thereof, the motion to extend is granted. Such extension is of a general nature and is not for the limited purpose of taking opposer's testimony deposition.<sup>1</sup>
