AMENDMENT

Applicant requests that the application be amended as follows:

1. In International Class 25, the description of goods should be amended to add the phrase "all relating to or promoting a university," such that the amended description shall be "clothing, namely, hats, shirts, pants, all relating to or promoting a university"

2. In International Class 41, the recitation of services should be amended to add the phrase "in a university context," such that the amended recitation shall be "education and entertainment services, namely, providing course of instruction at the university level; educational research; arranging and conducting athletic events and tournaments, exhibitions, conferences, live performances and festivals in a university context."

It is respectfully submitted that this amendment does not require republication as the amendment of goods and services narrows rather than broadens the scope of the application.
