On August 6, 2007, the parties filed applicant's proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 78662163, with opposer's written consent, and opposer's withdrawal of the opposition, without prejudice, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of services in International Class 41 **from:**

"Educational services, namely, conducting workshops and seminars in the field of espionage, cryptology, disguises, surveillance, chemistry and devices used in espionage, and magic; and entertainment services in the nature of live and prerecorded presentations in the field of espionage, cryptology, disguises, surveillance, chemistry and devices used in espionage, and magic"

to:

"Educational services, namely, conducting workshops and seminars in the field of espionage, cryptology,

disguises, surveillance, chemistry and devices used in espionage; and entertainment services in the nature of live presentations in the field of espionage, cryptology, disguises, surveillance, chemistry and devices used in espionage; and entertainment services in the nature of live and prerecorded presentations in the field of espionage, cryptology, disguises, surveillance, chemistry and devices used in espionage as displayed or portrayed at or as associated with or pertaining to the International Spy Museum."

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed without prejudice in accordance with the agreement between the parties.
