OPPOSER’S MOTION TO EXTEND

Opposer Foreign Threat Assessment Center, Inc., a Colorado corporation, through its counsel, SPARKS WILLSON BORGES BRANDT & JOHNSON, P.C., respectfully moves the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board to extend the discovery and trial dates relating to the above opposition.

1. On June 5, 2007, Opposer filed a Motion for Default Judgment requesting that the Board enter a default judgment against Applicant with prejudice and that the registration of the mark in Application Serial No. 78/813,830 be denied. See ESTTA tracking number ESTTA144284.
2. Allowing 40 days for Applicant’s response, the motion was pending for decision as of July 15, 2007, but has not yet been ruled on by the Board.

WHEREFORE, Opposer Foreign Threat Assessment Center, Inc. respectfully requests that the Board revise the scheduling for this matter to allow the Board time to rule on the pending June 5 Motion for Default Judgment.


