By the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board:

On May 10, 2007, the parties filed a stipulation to amend applicant's involved application Serial No. 78693304 and to withdraw the opposition with prejudice upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment, applicant seeks to delete "pens;" from the identification of goods in International Class 16. The amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b). Because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed with prejudice in accordance with the parties' stipulation.
