On October 3, 2008, the parties filed applicant's proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 78965234, with opposer's consent, and opposer's withdrawal of the opposition without prejudice, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of goods from:

"Biometric security and identification software".

to:

"Biometric security and identification software for computer access and access to electronically stored or electronically disseminated information on computers or computer networks".

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed without prejudice in accordance with the agreement between the parties.
