resolution is possible based upon the information exchanged. The parties request that the Board re-suspend proceedings for sixty days to allow them to continue and complete this process.


In a telephone conversation of July 7, 2008, Daniel E. Kattman, Esquire, counsel for Applicant, consented to the re-suspension of proceedings.
